Pharmacy league to push new cough medicine

The Pharmaceutical Industry Technology and Development Center (PITDC) teamed with Shun Tien Biotechnology Company along with Lien An Biotechnology Company and Huai Te New Medicine, two subsidiaries of Maywufa Group, are to form the first pharmaceutical league in Taiwan with a view to developing and promoting a new medicine, codenamed PDC-748 for the global market.

The PDC-748 has completed research prior to clinical trials which showed the product to be a major breakthrough in modern cough medicine. The league plans to push for multinational clinical trials and apply for the approval of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration when the new drug enters the preliminary clinical trial phase.

"With the assistance of the Office of Herbal Medicine of Ministry of Economic Affairs, the establishment of the first pharmaceutical league will help the medical industry launch strategies for global market and form a new model of management," said Chen Kuan-chi, vice chairperson of Huai Te New Medicine, also the organizer of the pharmaceutical league.
